## Scriptures on the Rapture: Christ's Coming FOR the Saints:

- 1) Pray always, that you may be accounted worthy <u>to escape</u> all these things...and to stand before the Son of man (Luke 21:36)
- 2) <u>In My Father's house</u> are many mansions...I go to prepare <u>a place</u> for you...I will <u>come again</u>, and <u>receive you to Myself;</u> that where I am, there you may be also. (John 14:1-3
- 3) We shall not all sleep (die physically), but we shall all be changed. In a moment...at the last trumpet...the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we (the living) shall be changed...put on immortality...then...death is swallowed up in victory. (2 Corinthians 15:51-56)
- 4) Christ loves the church...that He might <u>present it to Himself</u>. Ephesians 5:25-27)
- 5) From whence (heaven) also we <u>look for</u>...Jesus Christ; Who shall <u>change our vile body</u>. (Philippians 3:11, 20-21; 2 Corinthians 5:1-9)
- 6) For the Lord Himself shall <u>descend from heaven</u>...the dead <u>in</u> <u>Christ</u> shall rise first. <u>Then</u> we which are alive and remain <u>shall be</u> <u>caught up</u> together <u>with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air</u> (not meet the Lord on earth to establish His Kingdom, rather we go back to heaven with Him) (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 2:19; 3:13; 5:9,23)
- 7) We beseech you...by <u>our gathering together unto Him</u>...until he be taken out of the way. (2 Thessalonians 2:1; 7-8)
- 8) When Christ...shall appear, then shall you also appear with Him in glory. (Colossians 3:4; 1 John 2:28; 3:2; 1 Peter 5:4)
- 9) Be patient...<u>unto</u> the coming of the Lord...<u>until</u> you <u>receive</u> the early and the latter rain. (James 5:7-8)

## Scriptures on the Second Advent: Christ's Coming WITH the saints:

- 1) One like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days and they brought Him near before Him. And there was given Him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages shall serve Him. (Daniel 2:44-45; 7:13-14,18, 27)
- 2) Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations...His <u>feet</u> shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which...shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west...the Lord my God shall come, and all the saints with You. (Zechariah 14:1-5,9,16-21)
- 3) <u>Immediately after the tribulation, then</u> shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and <u>they shall see</u> the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven <u>with</u> power and great glory. (Matthew 24:29-31)
- 4) When the Son of man shall come in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then shall He sit upon the throne of His glory.

  And before Him shall be gathered all nations. (Matthew 25:31-46)
- 5) When the Lord shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels. In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God. (2 Thessalonians 1:7-10; 2:8)
- 6) The Lord cometh <u>with</u> ten thousands of His saints, to execute judgement upon all...that are ungodly. (Jude 14-15)
- 7) He comes <u>with</u> clouds; and every eye shall see Him...all kindred of the earth shall wail because of Him...the armies of heaven followed Him upon white horses. (Revelation 1:7; 19:11-21; 20:1-3; Isaiah 63:1-6; Joel 3)
